4. The purpose of processing personal data and the legitimate grounds for processing

Globe Art Point is a non-profit association that promotes the position and employment of foreign-based professional artists and art workers residing in Finland and the diversity of Finnish art and culture sector.

The processing of personal data transferred to Globe Art Point is based on the legal bases of Article 6 of the EU Data Protection Regulation and the Personal Data Act (523/1999). The data will be stored for as long as the functional connection to the original use remains. The starting point is to minimize data retention times to keep unnecessary data.

The Artistic Database (a) is an open search database that is managed through the Gruppo database program. The artist database includes information of non-Finnish-born artists and art workers resident in Finland who have sent them to the association. The purpose of the database on the association's website is to support the visibility and employability of artists in various art projects and events.

The Customer Register (b) is a register for internal use that is managed through the Gruppo Database Program. Through the customer register, the association's monthly newsletters and other information materials are sent to customers and stakeholders.

Legality of processing of data Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council (General Data Protection Regulation) Article 6 (1), processing is lawful only if and only to the extent that at least one of the following conditions is met:

- X a) the data subject has consented to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more purposes;
- b) processing is necessary for the implementation of a contract in which a party is a party to a contract or for the adoption of pre-contractual measures at the request of a data subject;
- c) processing is necessary to comply with the statutory obligation of the controller;
- d) processing is necessary to protect the vital interests of a registered or other natural person;
- e) processing is necessary in order to carry out a task of general interest or to exercise the public authority of a controller;

X f) processing is necessary for the fulfillment of the legitimate interests of the controller or a third party; except when the data protection interests or fundamental rights and freedoms require the protection of personal data, especially if the registered child is a child.

6. Regular sources of information

The art database (a) collects information on open search organized by the association on social media twice a year.

The customer database (b) collects information by asking people interested in the activity of the association whether they wish to send newsletters and other newsletters to the association.

X The system is technically protected and used in a secure connection. The system is protected by usernames and passwords.

X Registry / System user rights are limited and system administrator manages user rights.

X Access to and access to the Register / System Information is limited by the limited employees of Globe Art Point.

X The information in the register is also protected against unauthorized viewing, modification and destruction.

X Security is based on user management, technical protection of databases and servers, physical protection of premises, access control, data security and data backup.

11. The right to require rectification or removal of information
